


## Course Objectives





# THE BIBLE IS NOT ONE BOOK...





OLD TESTAMENT








Of the 66 books, 27 were written soon after the death of Jesus:





- Look back from the death of Moses to the creation of the world













- History of the nation of Israel, from the possession of the land to the return from captivity.









- Song of Solomon poem about true romantic love







- Silent for 400 years preceding Christ's birth













- Matthew, Mark, and John were eyewitnesses; Luke knew many of the eyewitnesses












